## How do I begin?

## How do I qualify for tuition assistance?

As a full-time or part-time employee at ACI, you qualify for tuition assistance at some level beginning six months after your start date. Applications for Tuition Assistance at ACI should be submitted **prior to the start of your coursework**. To apply, please visit the [ACI Tuition Assistance Program Page](#).

When you enroll as a full-time student at Bellevue University seeking an associate or a bachelor's degree, or either a full-time or part-time student at Bellevue University seeking a master's degree, you are eligible for **double the typical ACI tuition assistance**. The amounts you are eligible for depend on your tier:

Employee Status	ACI Tuition Assistance	Total Benefit when you attend Bellevue University
Tier 3 full-time and part-time employees:	\$5,250	<b>\$10,500</b>
Tier 2 full-time and part-time employees:	\$3,500	<b>\$7,000</b>
Tier 1 full-time and part-time employees:	\$2,500	<b>\$5,000</b>

If you are using this program to earn an associate or a bachelor's degree, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online. The Bellevue University school code is 002538. You must maintain a GPA of 2.0 in undergraduate programs and a 3.0 in graduate programs to sustain the benefits.

## Does my spouse, son, daughter, mom, dad qualify for tuition assistance?

Yes. As long as you have been employed at ACI for at least six months, each of your immediate family members is eligible for up to \$2,500 in annual tuition assistance when enrolled as a full-time student, seeking a degree. Those using this program to earn an associate or a bachelor's degree must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online. The Bellevue University school code is 002538. You must maintain a GPA of 2.0 in undergraduate programs and a 3.0 in graduate programs to sustain the benefits.

## Do I have to be a full-time student to qualify for this tuition assistance program?

If you are enrolling in an associate or a bachelor's degree program, yes. At Bellevue University, traditional semester-based programs are 12 weeks and full-time status for undergraduates is defined as eight credit hours per semester. If you enroll in an accelerated cohort program, you take only one course at a time, and all cohort programs qualify as full-time programs.

For master's degrees, you do not need to be a full-time student. You need only to take one course, or three credit hours to take advantage of this tuition assistance benefit.

## Are employees who are currently enrolled in Bellevue University eligible for this tuition assistance program?

Current Bellevue University students should check with their Bellevue University Student Coach to see if they're eligible for this program. If you are, you will need to let your Coach know that you're interested in participating and, **after this is complete**, eligibility will start at the following term. In no case will the expanded tuition assistance be granted retroactively.

## What kind of support does Bellevue University provide?

Bellevue University offers academic advising, online tutoring, a writing center, military veteran services, and ongoing professional development webinars. Plus, they'll work with you to help you create a degree plan and stick to that plan.

## Are other forms of financial aid available?

Yes! When you combine the generous tuition assistance with other sources of education funding, the amount you may have to borrow to fund the remainder of your degree program can be very low.

Because Bellevue University is a regionally accredited university, they participate in all major federal and state grant and loan programs to pay any direct education costs remaining, such as tuition, books, and supplies.

Here are types of federal financial aid you may qualify for:

- **Pell Grants** – Awards of up to \$7,395 for the 2023–2024 school year if you can demonstrate exceptional financial need. This is a grant program set aside by the federal government for individuals who meet financial aid guidelines. Because it is a grant, it does not need to be repaid.
- **Veterans Education Benefits** – Bellevue University welcomes Education Benefits and has VA-approved experts who will work with you to access and use the education funding you're entitled to.

Please NOTE: In order to ensure that you have funding to cover your entire degree program, we make sure you have access to all available funding and we limit the amount of tuition assistance you can access each academic term.

## What's the difference between a grant and a loan?

A grant does not have to be repaid. A loan must be repaid with interest following graduation or if you stop before graduating.

## How do I qualify for these types of aid?

Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online. The Bellevue University Title IV code is 002538.

## I've already earned some college credit.

### Can I apply that to my Bellevue University degree?

Yes. Bellevue University lets you transfer in your previous college credits without a transfer fee! If you have an associate degree, they will accept all the credits in your degree in full. You can also get credit for professional and military training, as well as for-credit exams like CLEP and DSST.

## Can I earn my degree from any college and still get this tuition assistance?

No. While ACI tuition assistance is available for approved coursework from any accredited university, these increased tuition assistance amounts are available exclusively to those who earn their degrees at Bellevue University. Bellevue University is a world leader in helping motivated, working adults earn their college degrees. We created this partnership with Bellevue University because of their long history and expertise in supporting motivated adult learners, including the support, generous credit transfer, and career-relevant education you need to make a difference real-time at ACI.

## Is there a specific degree that this tuition assistance applies to?
